

Magellan recently hosted three provider town halls across Pennsylvania

Magellan Behavioral Health of Pennsylvania (Magellan) hosted three provider town hall meetings in September and October. Over 200 providers and local stakeholders attended the following town halls:

Each town hall offered an opportunity for Magellan leadership to provide updates on the organization’s key priorities and initiatives, including integrated models of care and whole person solutions.
