Public Health Emergency (PHE) and Medical Assistance

The Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) recently announced that they are preparing for the eventual end of the federal COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE) declaration. Currently there is no specific date for the end of the PHE.
